

This is downtown Lisbon, photographed from one of the best spots available to the public.



THE LX FACTORY is a unique place in Lisbon. It is an old industrial area converted into a very busy and interesting hub. You will see bars and restaurants, shops of all kinds, lots of street art and a decadent architecture that glues it all together. The location is the Alcantara district and you can go there by tram.

The photography potential is huge! One thing that catches your eyes is the amount of



street art. You will need time to process all that apparent chaos, but the photos will be fantastic. It is a very good place to go with your friends or family, because while you think about your next photo, they can relax and have a drink.

So your main concern will be to compose simple, yet powerful photos, with the extra challenge of avoiding the crowd. That's why we are in business and LISBON PHOTO will give you a hand. Make it two hands!

Although you can use a mid-range telephoto lens, wide-angle is probably better. It is a very effective way to produce clean images, because you can get rid of all the people and still get the whole set. Should your camera be "big", our advise is to keep a low profile near the entrance - you don't want to be stamped as a pro.

The LX Factory is a magnet to the tourists and to the locals too.

Photography can be quite stylish, from colour to black & white, from wide-angle to detail.

NIGHT PHOTOGRAPHY is

also possible in more than one location, so yes, you can also do it in Lisbon.

LISBON PHOTO chose two totally different districts, one displaying old, the other as a modern architecture site. Hard to choose, so if you are a night photography enthusiast, you should do both.

A tripod is absolutely needed, so if you don't have one or you find it hard to travel with, you can count on one piece that you can rent as part of the tour.

The blue hour is probably one of the nicest times of the day to shoot. It is ephemeral, so it is very important to get the lesson well studied before you come.

As expected, LISBON PHOTO will give you some hints, eventually adding a blue hour session to the end of your afternoon tour or at the beginning of your night tour.

Anything is possible, depending on weather and time of the year.

Keep in mind that in some places it's not allowed to shoot with a tripod. You will need the help of experts to optimize your time and your photos. This is one of the purposes of LISBON PHOTO.
